Hill picked for “mega projects” in Egypt

Hill International has won a contract to project-manage two “mega mixed-use projects” near Cairo, Egypt.

The schemes are “Taj City”, a luxury residential and commercial development, and “Sairai”, set to be “Cairo’s entertainment destination”, the company said yesterday.

It was hired by Madinet Nasr for Housing & Development (MNHD), a public real estate development company.

Hill said Taj City will have “luxurious residential units, commercial areas, a world-class hotel, mall, expert medical facilities, and an international school”.

Sarai will “feature a variety of residential, commercial, retail, and leisure ventures”, Hill said.

Elsewhere in Egypt, China State Construction Engineering Corporation (CSCEC) last month poured the foundations for the “Iconic Tower”, a 385-metre-high office tower in the New Administrative Capital under construction 45km east of Cairo, Xinhua [reported](#).

Billed as Africa’s tallest tower, it is one of 20 towers CSCEC is building for the new capital’s central business district.
