

# CTA Construction joins Town of Weymouth officials at Ribbon Cutting for New Tufts Library

Weymouth, Mass. – CTA Construction Managers on Monday joined Town of Weymouth officials and other community leaders at the formal ribbon cutting for the new Tufts Library – a 50,000 square foot facility located on Broad Street in Weymouth.

The new library features a greatly expanded children’s literature department, several community meeting rooms, innovative technological advancements, and an outdoor amphitheater. In addition, the building features a large lobby with a café for patrons, a digital media lab with updated computer software and space designated specifically for teen activities.

“The New Tufts Library will be a valued part of the Weymouth community for decades to come. I appreciate the partnership and efforts of the great team we put together, including CTA Construction, who helped make today a reality,” said Weymouth Mayor Robert Hedlund.

CTA Construction worked closely with the City of Weymouth, project architect Tappe Architects, Inc. and the owner’s project manager, Hill International, on the Tufts Library project. It was a cooperative venture between the Town of Weymouth and the Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners, which awarded Weymouth over \$12 million for the construction of a new library.
